## **INFORMATION CLAUSE**

- 3. The legal basis for the processing of personal data is Art. 6 sec. 1 lit. c, e GDPR, i.e.:
  - fulfilment of the legal obligations incumbent on the administrator, in particular those resulting from the rules for determining the curriculum of higher education, in accordance with applicable law;
  - performance of a task carried out in the public interest, consisting in particular of conducting scientific activity, providing research services and transferring knowledge and technology to the economy.
- Personal data will be processed in order to implement the PLANET4 project (<u>https://www.planet4project.eu/</u>), the purpose of which is to support educational processes related to modern technologies in the area of Industry 4.0.
- 5. Providing the data is necessary to achieve the purposes for which they were collected. Refusal to provide them will prevent participation in the PLANET4 project.
- Personal data will not be disclosed to external entities, except for Project PLANET4 Partners (<u>https://www.planet4project.eu/project-partners/</u>) and cases provided for by law, nor will personal data be transferred to a recipient in a third country or an international organization.
- 7. Personal data will be processed until you resign from participation in the PLANET4 project, or until the end of activities related to PLANET4, and after this period, stored for the time and for the purpose and scope required by law in connection with the settlement of the project and its evaluation, no for more than 5 years after the end of the project. After the expiry of the storage period, your data will be irretrievably deleted.
- 8. The Administrator may entrust the processing of personal data to external entities acting on behalf of the Administrator, e.g. entities providing legal services, IT services in the field of development, servicing and removal of failures in IT systems.
- 9. You have the right to access your data, rectify it, delete it or limit its processing, and the right to object to its processing, if permitted by law.
- 10. The data subject has the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory body (i.e. the President of the Personal Data Protection Office), if he or she considers that the processing of personal data violates the provisions of the GDPR.
